Course Objectives

The purpose of this CME program is to provide a one day course on the basics of head and neck radiology. The curriculum will be divided into six sections: Spaces of the Head & Neck; Larynx; Oral Cavity & Oropharynx; Temporal Bone & Skull Base; Sinonasal and Lymph Nodes. Each topic will consist of lectures that will cover imaging technique, normal anatomy, and common pathology with an emphasis on how the imaging findings directly affect patient management and treatment. Both adult and pediatric pathology will be covered. One of the unique aspects that we hope will separate this program from others will be an emphasis on audience interaction and participation as opposed to structured lectures as are presented at most CME courses. We intend to limit the number of participants to ensure this interaction and maximize the educational experience. It is our hope that at the end of the day, participants will say the course was "too basic." If so, then you will have unwittingly learned and understood a tremendous amount of head & neck radiology!

Who Should Attend:

- Radiology residents at all levels of training, but especially 4th year residents preparing for oral boards
- Neuroradiology fellows preparing for the CAQ examination.
- Community radiologists who wish to gain a better understanding of head & neck radiology
- Neuroradiologists with a desire to obtain further impact on how imaging findings directly impact patient care and review for the CAQ or MOC examination.
- Radiology CT & MR technologists as an emphasis on optimizing imaging technique will be reviewed for each section.
- ENT physicians, ENT residents and other physicians who participate in the care of patients with head and neck disorders that would like a concise, one-day refresher course on head & neck imaging.

Accreditation and Credit Designation
